

CLASSROOM QUESTIONS - JUNE 2022

Reading Comprehension

- 1. *Jennifer Chan Is Not Alone* is about a girl trying to fit in at her new school, but she's bullied because she believes in aliens. Discuss the subject of bullying with students and ask them to write about some of the ways they can be kind when they meet a new student in their class.
- 2. After realizing she didn't know the names of her school custodial workers who provide a big contribution, teen author Olivia Amiri says it's important to recognize everyone. Ask students to write about someone who they think contributes a lot, such as a bus driver, store clerk, or mailman, and the ways they make it easier for everyone.
- 3. One of teen author Taylor Moxey's tips for setting goals is that they need to be realistic and reachable. She doesn't want kids to overwhelm themselves. Ask students to think of three goals they'd like to accomplish at some point and to write about each of them.
- 4. *Fishy Tales* is about a school of fish that discovers a sea creature stuck in a pile of trash in the ocean, and highlights the problems of trash being thrown into the ocean. Discuss this topic with students and the need for everyone to recycle. Ask them to write about things they recycle and other ways they can protect our environment.
- 5. Librarian and college professor Rose Brock says that books have the power to help readers escape, think, connect, see more for themselves than their current situation, and to be more kind by engaging with stories. Ask students to think of and write about one book they read that had an impact on them in any of these ways.
